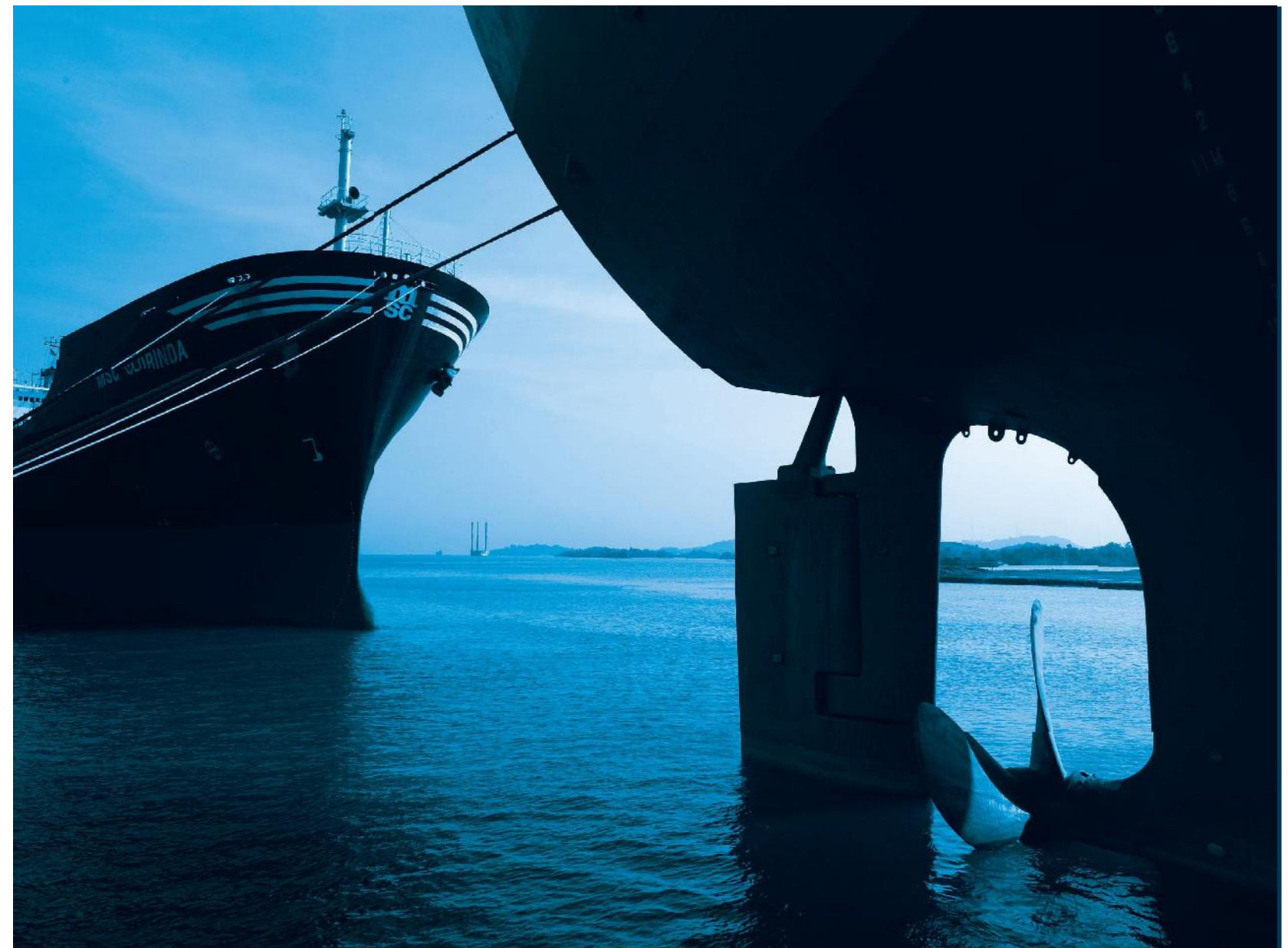

Our extensive fleet of offshore support vessels currently serves customers from the Middle East, Europe, Australia and China. Our fleet currently includes tankers, general bulk/cargo vessels, anchor handling tugs (AHTs), tugs and barges.

In addition to standard ship chandlery services, providing food, supplies and ship maintenance supplies 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, we also support immigration and visa processing between Singapore and Batam.

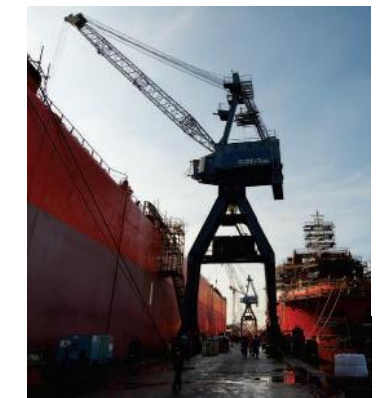


OUR SERVICES Proven expertise

Rig Building / Offshore Fabrication

Drydocks World - Graha is a purpose built, dedicated rig and offshore fabrication facility in Batam. With five building berths, extensive fabrication areas, covered workshops, specialist jigs, ample storage and a trained workforce, the yard is capable of delivering up to five units per year.

Shipbuilding
